

**Scrap Metal Affidavit of Ownership**

If a seller of nonferrous scrap, metal articles, proprietary articles, and railroad scrap, including catalytic converters, does not provide a bill of sale, itemized receipt, or letter of authorization signed by the seller to the scrap metal processor who purchases the item(s), then the scrap metal processor must request and collect a written affidavit of ownership by the seller that states that the seller lawfully owns the items to be sold. See 9 V.S.A. § 3022.
